CBD Application: Frequently Asked Questions

Purchase Agreements:

“I have not entered a Purchase Agreement; what do I submit?”

Please fill out the Unlicensed Affirmation form linked on the upload section of the application and attach it. When you do enter into a purchase agreement, please notify the OCR via email (dbr.hempcompliance@dbr.ri.gov).

“There is no CBD or Hemp license in the state my supplier is from; what do I do?”

Please fill out the Unlicensed Affirmation form linked on the upload section of the application and attach it in the Purchase Agreement section.

Traceability:

“What do you want for traceability?”

Please write a document describing how you track your products from Receiving to Point of Sale. This is important in case of recalls so you can know where the products are and how many you have left.

Zoning:

“There are no CBD related zoning requirements in my municipality, what do I submit?”

We will accept a sales-at-retail certificate or other proof of your ability to conduct sales in the municipal zone that you are located in.

“I am an online retailer; do I need to submit something for Zoning?”

Please submit proof that you are certified to conduct sales in your municipality/state.
