



NATIONAL CRIME INFORMATION CENTER CHECK (NCIC)

In accordance with The Rhode Island Cannabis Act, Rhode Island General Laws Chapter 21-28.11, all Adult-Use Retail Store owners, members, officers, directors, managers and agents will be subject to a national criminal background check as part of their application for a commercial cannabis identification card.

Please obtain a background check (NCIC) from your local police department, the Rhode Island Department of the Attorney General (401-274-4400, located at 4 Howard Avenue, Cranston, RI 02920), or by appointment with the Rhode Island State Police (401-444-1000). Please contact these sources with any questions about the process. Applicants are responsible for any expenses associated with the NCIC.

As part of the NCIC your fingerprints will be taken and submitted to the FBI. Once the check has been processed the results will be sent directly to the Cannabis Control Commission and a copy will be sent to you. Please bring this form to the law enforcement agency and inform them that you are applying for a NCIC related to an **Adult-Use Cannabis Retail License** so the results are sent to the correct agency.
