



QR Code Approval Checklist

Package and Labeling Requirements outlined in 560-RICR-10-10-2.7.2(G) allow some information to be included in a QR code or on packaging for retail-ready cannabis products. Notice there are core labeling requirements that still must appear on the package pursuant to 560-RICR-10-10-2.7.2. Please email CCC.CannabisCompliance@ccc.ri.gov with the proposed QR code, an image of your product packaging or list of required information that will be on the packaging, and completed QR Code Approval Checklist for each product type. A QR code approval is not required for every SKU/Metric source tag.
