Definition of a “Disproportionately Impacted Area”

The Cannabis Act defines “**disproportionately impacted area**” as a census tract or geographic area that satisfies at least one of the following criteria:

1. The area has a poverty rate of at least 20%, according to the latest federal decennial census.
2. 75% or more of the children in the area participate in the federal free lunch program according to reported statistics from the Rhode Island Board of Education.
3. At least 20% of the households in the area receive assistance under SNAP.
4. The area has an average unemployment rate, as determined by RIDLT, that is more than 120% of the national unemployment average, as determined by the US Department of Labor, for a period of at least 2 consecutive calendar years preceding the date of the application.
5. The area has disproportionately high rates of arrest, conviction, and incarceration related to the sale, possession, use, cultivation, manufacture, or transportation of cannabis in comparison to other communities, or has a history of arrests, convictions, and other law enforcement practices that reflect a disparate enforcement of cannabis prohibition when compared to the remainder of the state.



§ 21-28.11-3(23). Definitions.

Project Progression: Disproportionately Impacted Area

- December 2023 – June 2024:
 - DIA question presented to the Cannabis Advisory Board (CAB) for review and discussion as required by § 21-28.11-3(39)
 - Worked with agency partners to collect necessary data for DIA pursuant to § 21-28.11-3 (23) and conduct preliminary data analysis
- June 2024:
 - Presentation to CCC and CAB on DIA preliminary analysis on municipality level
 - CAB and community feedback urged Commission to conduct more granular analysis to identify specific DIAs within municipalities
- July – September 2024:
 - CAB recommendation: At least three or more of the statutory criteria be met for a municipality to be considered a disproportionately impacted area
 - Identified and further evaluated data at census tract level: unemployment rate, SNAP, poverty rate
- October 2024:
 - Presentation to the CCC on updated DIA project

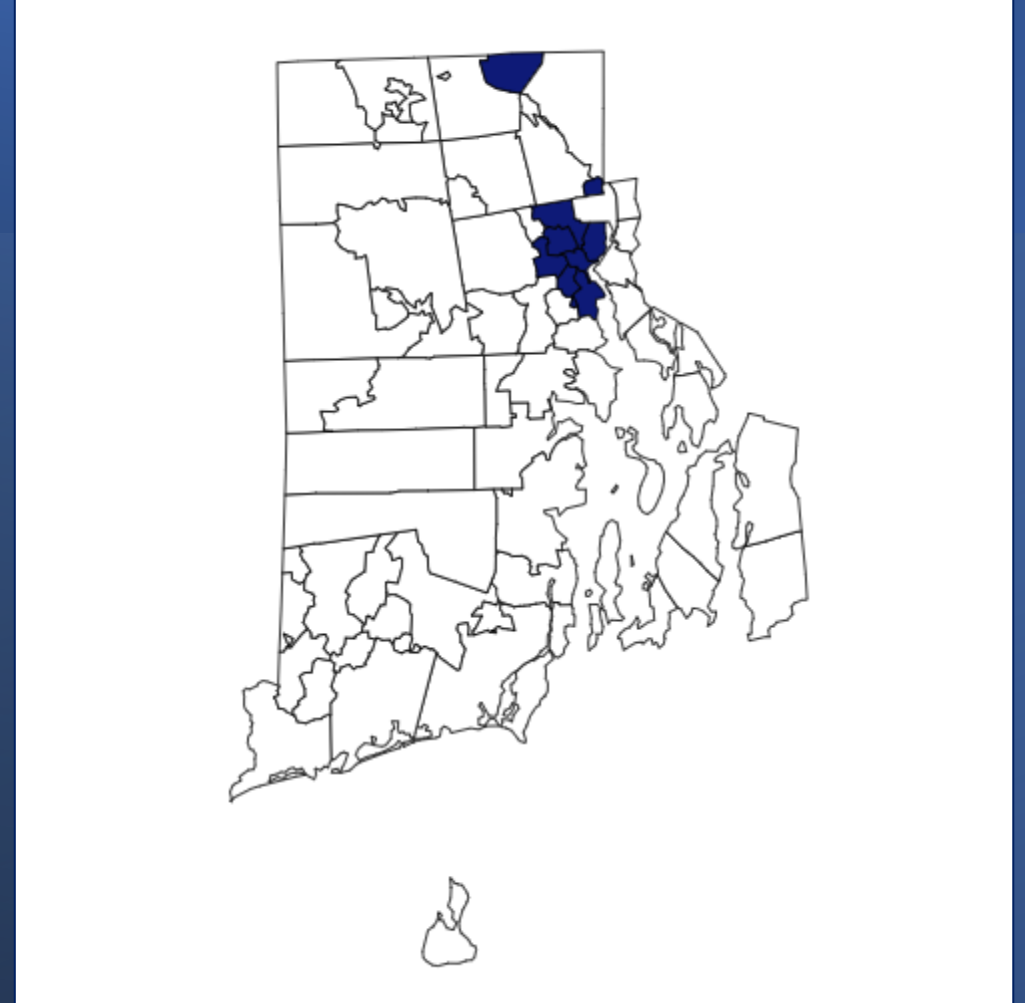

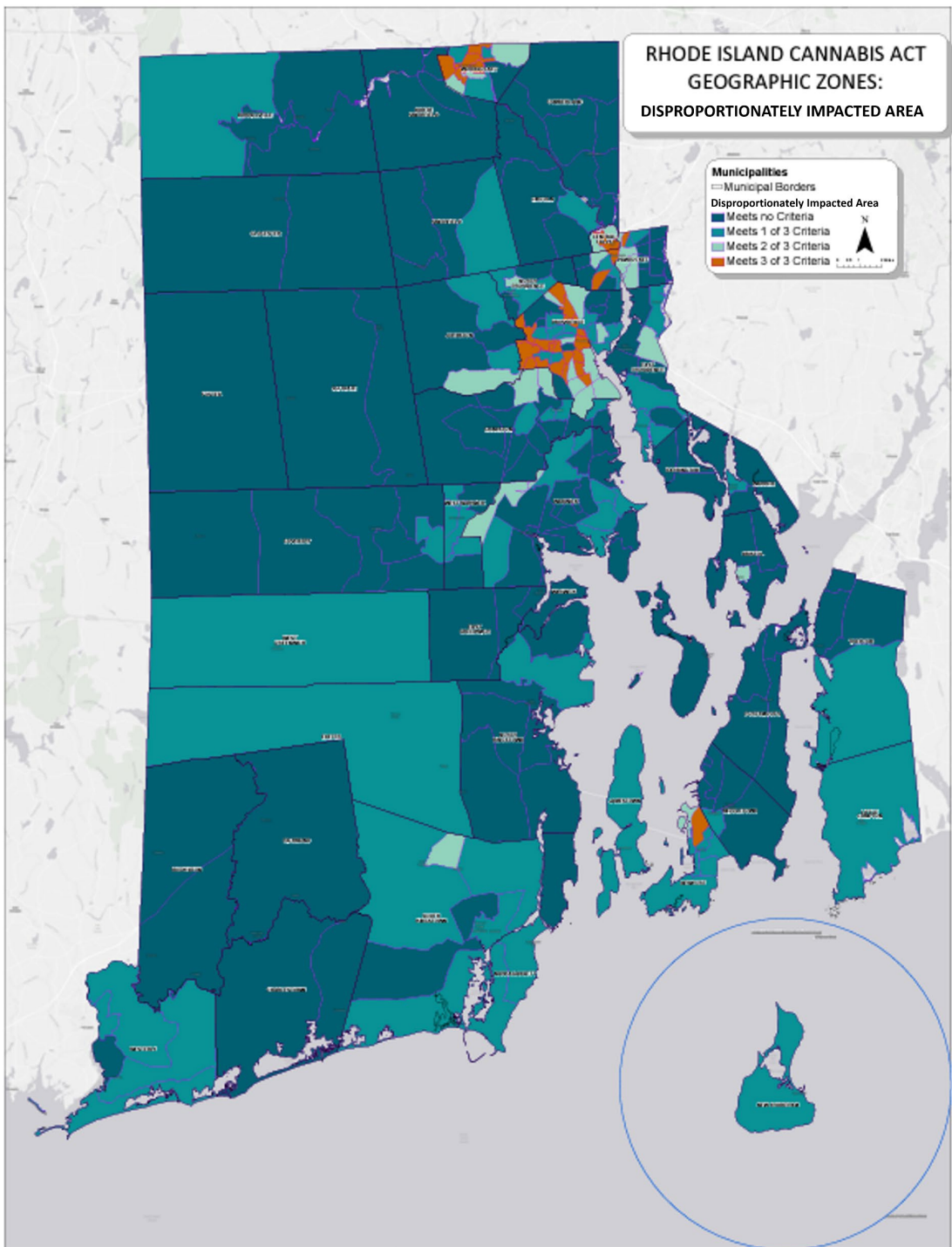

RIDOH Analysis of Rhode Island Census Tracts that Meet 3/3 DIA criteria available at census tract level:

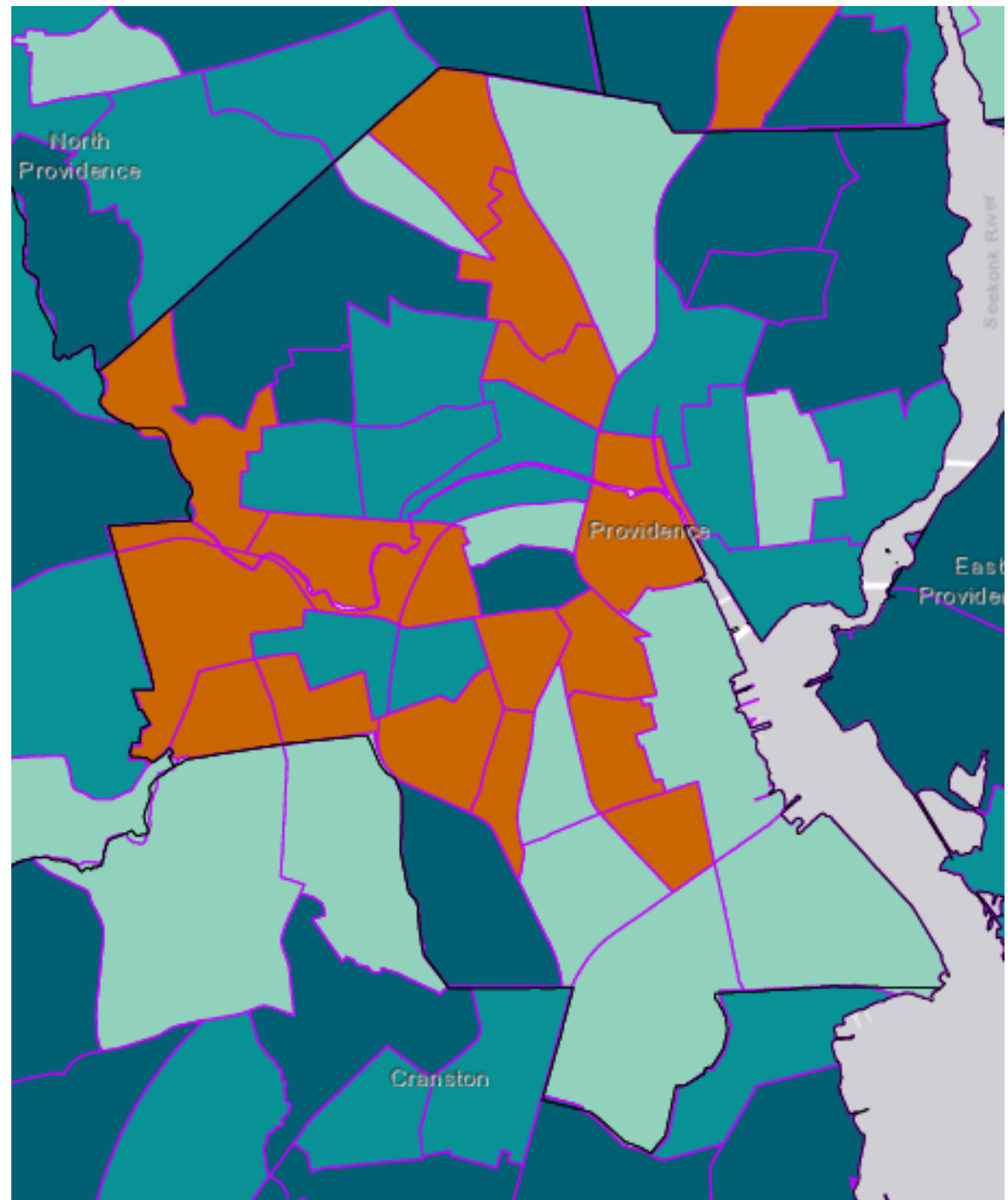
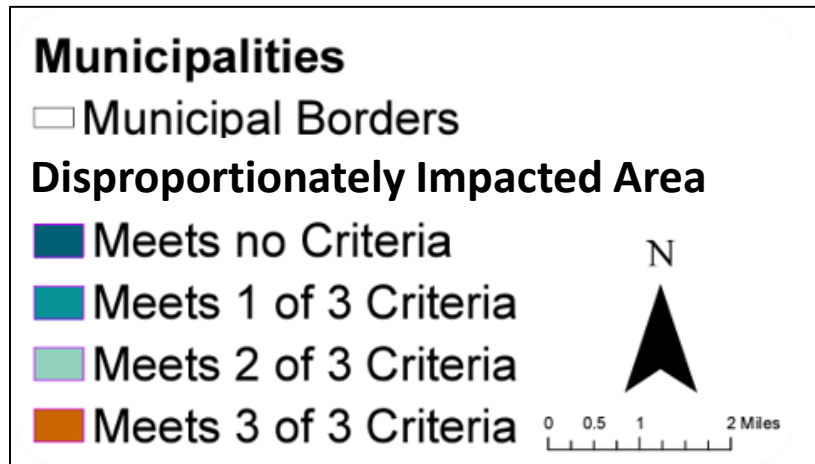
SNAP, Unemployment Rate, and Poverty Rate

 - 1 out of 8 total census tracts in Newport
- **Pawtucket:**
 - 3 out of 21 total census tracts in Pawtucket



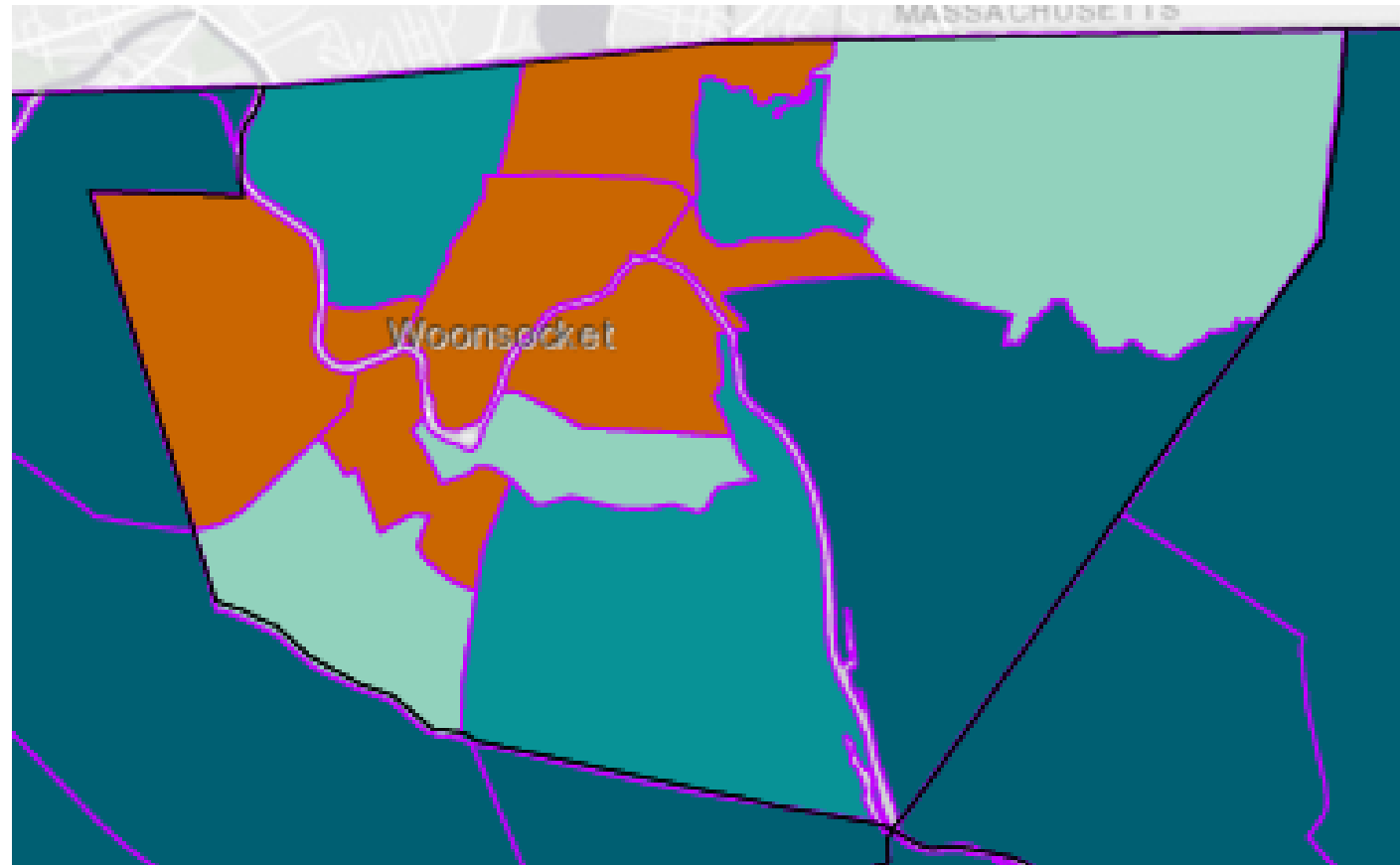
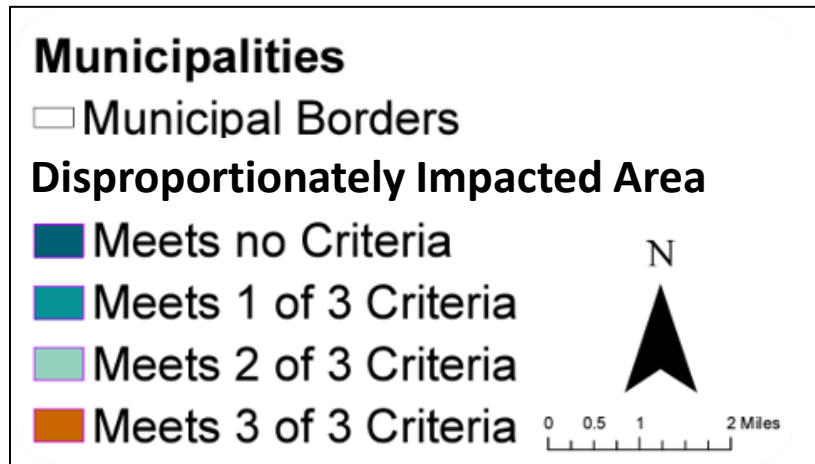



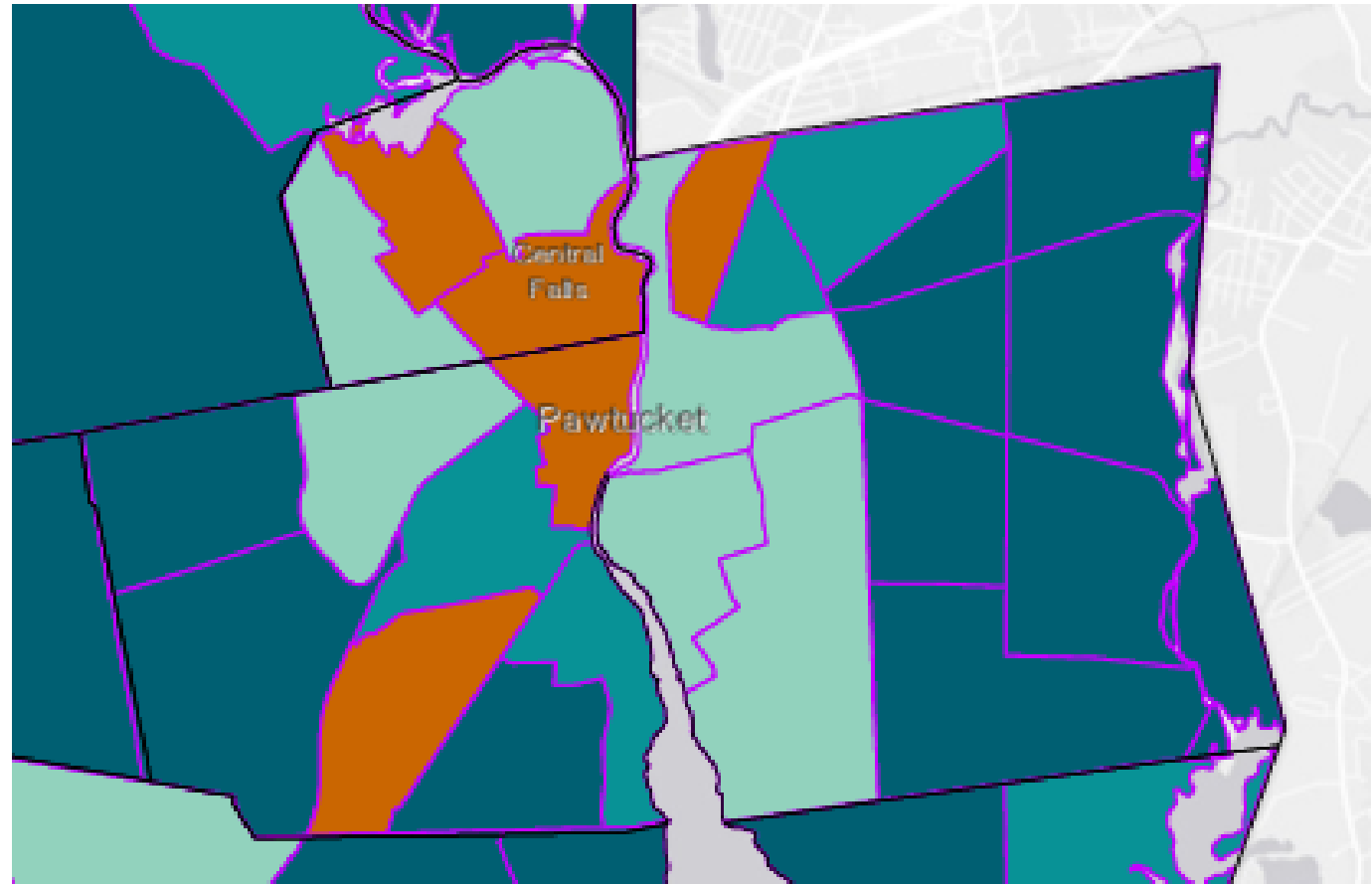

Takeaways:

- Preliminary data analysis identified municipalities that met all five data sets outlined in the Rhode Island Cannabis Act
- Community feedback urged the Commission to examine more granular level analysis to define areas that are disproportionately impacted
- Census tract analysis further specifies which areas are disproportionately impacted by statutorily required criteria
- Confirmed that areas within Central Falls, Providence, and Woonsocket, at a census tract level, remain identified DIAs
- Data analysis on a census tract level demonstrates a more accurate depiction of impacted communities in Rhode Island
